## As Amended September 25, 1991 DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

## SECTION A. Fire Arms

For the purpose of protection of persons and property:

- 1. The discharge of firearms within one mile of Memorial Hall is hereby prohibited, except on or within a properly supervised rifle or pistol range.
- 2. Any person found guilty of a violation of this ordinance shall upon conviction be subject to a fine of not more than \$25.00 for each said offense to be recovered for the use of the Town.

## SECTION B. Concealed Weapon Permits

- 1. The Oakland Chief of Police or the person acting as Chief in his/her absence shall be the issuing authority for Concealed Weapons Permits, under M.R.S.A. Title 25, Chapter 252.
- 2. The application fee for a Concealed Weapon Permit and renewal shall be as specified by State law.
