### Business Agenda:

1. It was moved by Dana Wrigley seconded by Robert Nutting and voted 5-0 approving the minutes of the meetings held on September 19<sup>th</sup>, 2018, and signing the disbursement warrant.
2. It was moved by Donald Borman seconded by Robert Nutting and voted 5-0 to place the proceeds from the sale of 97 Church Street into the Municipal Building reserve account.
3. It was moved by Dana Wrigley seconded by Harold Buzzell and voted 5-0 to post the proposed taxi cab ordinance. Further information will be available at the next Council meeting relative to concerns of the council. Councilor Borman requested further verification pertaining to "Section 6 – Required Inspections". He asked what criteria is being followed when the Police Chief conducts the vehicle inspections prior to issuing a license to the operator.
4. It was moved by Dana Wrigley seconded by Robert Nutting and voted 5-0 to approve the second reading of the amendments to the General Assistance ordinance as proposed by Department of Human Services.
5. It was moved by Donald Borman seconded by Harold Buzzell and voted 5-0 to appoint Mark Stevens, as alternate member, to the Planning Board (term expiring June 2021).
6. It was moved by Dana Wrigley seconded by Harold Buzzell and voted 5-0 to approve the Sewer Commitment in the amount of \$139,588.76 for the user period July 1<sup>st</sup> thru September 30, 2018.
7. It was moved by Dana Wrigley seconded by Robert Nutting and voted 5-0 to approve the sewer abatement, for property located at 24 Center Street, in the amount of \$1,110.00. Town sewer billing records show that starting in June 2011 through the current billing; the

home was charged for two (2) sewer units. Verification from the Assessor's records confirmed that this is a single family dwelling along with the owner stating that his current business is not conducted within the home.
