Business Agenda:

- It was moved by Dana Wrigley seconded by Robert Nutting and voted 5-0 approving the minutes of the meetings held on October 10th, 2018, and signing the disbursement warrant.
- 2. It was moved by Dana Wrigley seconded by Harold Buzzell and voted 5-0 to approve renewing the transfer station 2019 Service Agreement (2 year contract) with Electronics End LLC.
- 3. It was moved by Dana Wrigley seconded by Robert Nutting and voted 5-0 to accept a donation from Ms. Sandra Theriault in the amount of \$706.26 to be used for the purchase of a vest for our Police Department.
- 4. It was moved by Dana Wrigley seconded by Donald Borman and voted 5-0 to accept the Safety Enhancement grant for the purchase of three (3) Ballistic Police Vest. The grant will cover two-thirds of the cost not exceeding \$1,910.27. Councilors continued discussion of the proposed taxi ordinance. The ordinance will be posted for a first reading at the November 14, 2018 Council meeting. Councilors suggested that a taxi cab should have a new motor vehicle inspection within one month prior to obtaining a taxi cab license. The Town Manager will include recommended changes for the first reading.
- 5. It was moved by Michael Perkins seconded by Dana Wrigley and voted 5-0 approving Christmas Eve (Monday 12/24) as a holiday for all non essential employees.
- It was moved by Dana Wrigley seconded by Harold Buzzell and voted 5-0 to accept the 2018 Homeland Security Grant for the purchase of one (1) Masimo RAD-57 meter not to exceed \$6,700.00. Upon purchase of the product Kennebec County Emergency

Management requires a copy of the purchase and a copy of the check for reimbursement purposes.
