Business Agenda:

- 1. Moved by Dana Wrigley seconded by Robert Nutting and voted 3-0 approving the minutes of the previous meeting and signing the municipal warrant.
- 2. Council members approved the appointment of Nichole Stenberg, as Assessor, with a term of office through December 31, 2024.
- 3. No action taken on the subdivision ordinance update.
- 4. Moved by Robert Nutting seconded by Dana Wrigley and voted 3-0 to approve the agreement proposed by MDOT that allows for a construction overlimit permit being issued by the town to the Contractor of said project. The permit allows the use of overweight equipment and loads on municipal ways and specifies that all truck speed will be a maximum of twenty-five (25) mph. The specific municipal roads involved are not necessarily known at the present time. Project entails "Ultra -Thin Bonded Wearing Course," interstate 95 northbound from Waterville to Pittsfield.
- 5. The Town Manager and Councilor Wrigley provided information regarding the Municipal Review Committee (MRC), which represents a group of 115 Maine cities and towns that joined together as a non- profit organization to manage their MSW issues. Fiberight originally operating the facility for six (6) months before shutting down in May of 2020. An opportunity to purchase the facility is being discussed but would require community support and co-signing on the loan. On Thursday, March 10th, a zoom meeting, will be conducted that will provide additional information for the sale/purchase and what implications towns will face in the future. Currently the towns' trash is taken to the Norridgewock landfill, known as Crossroads Landfill.
